Read:- R. & B. G.R.No.MCN-1671/97/Pt.IV/H, dated 1-10-1980.

The guide book on transfer of used equipment as published by Central Water Commission in 1975 was the main basis on which the G.R. under reference dtd. 1-10-80 was issued by the then R.&B. Department. In accordance with the above resolution, the life of heavy transport vehicles above 5 tonnes payload capacity has been considered as 2 lakhs Km. or 10 years and the repair provision during its life span kept as 140% maximum. It was however been observed they have been rendering trouble free service beyond 2 lakhs Km. with periodical maintenance and repairs. Performance of these vehicles beyond 2 lakhs Kms. has been noticed to be quite satisfactory and many of them have been still in use. This has been possible because of adequate repairs facilities, adoption of periodical maintenance and greater technological knowhow attained during the use of the vehicles. It has also been possible as many components of the vehicles have been improved in metallurgy.

It has also been noticed that transport vehicles below 5 tonnes payload capacity have been marketed now and are in use.

The issue of revision in the life of these transport vehicles was under consideration of Government from some time past. Govt. is now pleased to decide the life of vehicles as under:-
